Inductive Reasoning

process of reasoning in which the premises are viewed as supplying some evidence for the touth of the conclusion.

VS.

Deductive Reasoning

process of reasoning from for more premises to reach a logically certain conclusion

## Inductive

Premise 1 There is a bag of coins.

Premise 2 A coin pulled from the bad is a penny.

Conclusion All the coins in the bag are pennies.

## Deductive

Premise 1 All men are mortal.

Premise 2 Barak Obama is a man.

Conclusion Barak Obama is mortal.
